

REGIONAL AQUATICS STRATEGY COMMUNITY FORUMS

About the Study

Sunshine Coast Regional Council is preparing a Regional Aquatics Strategy.

The purpose of the Strategy is to guide the current and future provision of aquatic facilities and services to meet the needs of diverse Sunshine Coast communities over the next 15 years.

The study will identify local and regional opportunities and shortcomings in aquatic facilities; and make recommendations on the revitalisation and sustainability of facilities.

Consultants *Strategic Leisure Group* have been engaged to assist in preparing the Regional Aquatics Strategy.

As part of the community engagement process a series of **Community Forums** are planned. The purpose of the Forums is to discuss:

- ~ Levels of satisfaction with existing pools
- ~ Constraints, opportunities, design or maintenance issues
- ~ Unmet facility or program needs
- ~ A 'vision' for aquatics for the region

Please note these forums are a combined meeting and will also be addressing Council's planning for a Regional Sport and Recreation Strategy.
